

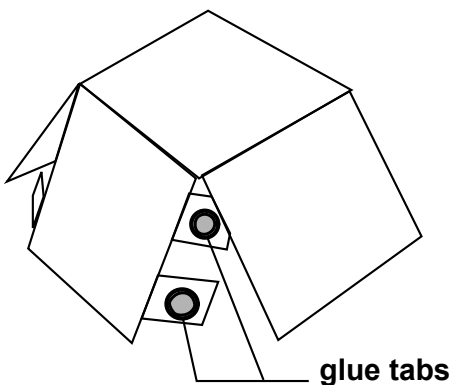
chair base

print on heavy paper for best results

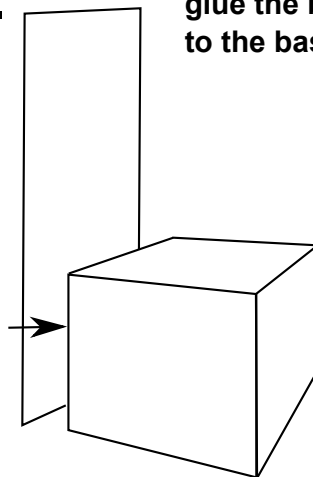


1. cut out the template and fold base



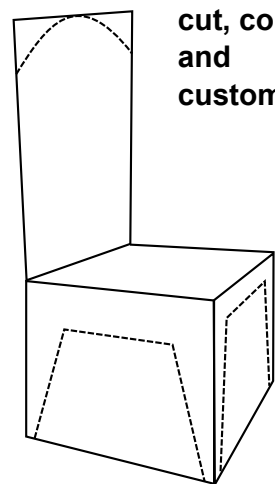
